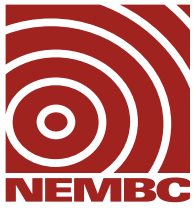
The grant is open all year round so you can make an application at any time that suits your project.

Grant Information & Guidelines

The Tony Manicaros Grant is open to ethnic and multicultural community broadcasters from across Australia to fund an innovative project which utilises, extends or develops opportunities in ethnic community radio broadcasting.

Up to \$2,000 can be given to a project, and the successful recipient will be featured in *The Ethnic Broadcaster*, on the NEMBC website, and receive an award at the NEMBC Annual Conference.

Any station, programming group or individual can apply. The grant is open all year round so you can make an application at any time that suits your project.

GRANT GUIDELINES

Simply fill out the application form. The more information you provide about the project the better. The grant can fund a broad range of projects, including:

Producing programs

- Produce and distribute information of benefit to ethnic programmers or stations with ethnic programming
- Produce special programming of significance to a national audience, specific target group or to mark significant historic or present day events

Online or Multiplatform

- Use other media to disseminate, document and promote radio programs through audio, print, visual or online media

Training

- Provide specialised training for broadcasters and particularly broadcasters underrepresented in ethnic community broadcasting

Archiving

- Assist with oral history, documenting or archiving of material of significance for ethnic community broadcasting

Research and Development

- Undertake study in the media that would assist a program or station in its programming, technical, administrative or management development

ABOUT THE GRANT

The Tony Manicaros Grant is given to commemorate and celebrate Tony Manicaros' work for ethnic community broadcasting on a station, state and national basis.

CONDITIONS OF THE GRANT

- The decision of the Tony Manicaros Grant Trustees is final.
- Funding of up to \$2,000 is available per project.
- A clear timeline must be set for the project.
- The NEMBC is to be given permission to promote or use the project for non-commercial purposes.
- A successful applicant cannot reapply in the following year.
- The award is a one-off grant.
